## PRODUCT DEVELOPMENT

Product Expansion from Solutions...

From enhancing an existing product through to new tool development, R&D remains a fundamental key component in the ongoing expansion of the Peak product range. It has long been the case that our bespoke solutions regularly become part of our product line and this product development is often borne by an immediate necessity for a particular tool.

By example, we were recently approached by a major Oil and Gas Operator and long standing client to supply a large bore releasable type spear which was designed to recover part of a 7" tubing string working in both 9 5/8" & 10 3/4" casing. To ensure the continuation of an existing product line, it was crucial that the design had to incorporate all of the features of the tried & tested *Peak Releasable Spear*. The Spear was designed, manufactured, put through a series of rigorous tests before finally being delivered on time.
